# How CNPC?

## Our Story

One of us international Nepalese students got severely affected by COVID-19 in 2021. He was in ICU for more than 2 months with life support from a ventilator and medically induced coma. The doctors were giving us hope that he would fight, and he did, we are grateful to the wonderful care from all the medical teams. But during those periods, it was one of the worst periods for us to fight with covid, dealing with emotions, preparedness and finding the resource, even with the worst case of financial arrangements and necessity management. The constant follow up to the hospital and sympathizing with the family was hard for us. Being an immigrant and living alone without family members is hard to live.

Thus, we felt that it is necessary to build a strong Nepalese community with a homeland environment by supporting in every possible way either emotional support, financial support, resources, and information sharing etc. Finally, he was discharged from the hospital, and we created this organization on Facebook on May15th, 2021 and federally incorporated as a community of Nepalese People in Canada / Communauté des Népalais au Canada (CNPC).
